

## **ABSTRAK**

**Analisis Masukan dan Proses Asuhan Pelayanan Nifas oleh Bidan Pelaksana di Wilayah Dinas Kesehatan Kota Semarang Tahun 2014**

Cakupan pelayanan nifas di Kota Semarang pada tahun 2011-2013 meningkat tetapi belum mencapai target 90 %. Berdasarkan hasil survey pendahuluan menunjukkan bahwa asuhan pelayanan nifas yang dilakukan oleh bidan pelaksana di wilayah Dinas Kesehatan Kota Semarang belum maksimal. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah menjelaskan bagaimana masukan dan proses asuhan pelayanan nifas di wilayah Dinas Kesehatan Kota Semarang.

Penelitian ini dilakukan secara kualitatif, Pengumpulan data dilakukan dengan cara wawancara mendalam dan observasi. Informan utama adalah 2 bidan pelaksana dari 2 puskesmas yang mempunyai cakupan kunjungan nifas tertinggi dan terendah. Informan triangulasi adalah 2 bidan koordinator dan 2 kepala puskesmas dari 2 puskesmas yang mempunyai cakupan kunjungan nifas tertinggi dan terendah. Data dianalisis dengan analisis isi.

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa pelaksanaan asuhan dari aspek input: SDM secara kuantitas masih kurang jumlahnya. secara kualitas, pengetahuan bidan mengenai asuhan nifas kurang, serta kebijakan untuk pelaksanaan asuhan nifas sesuai standar belum ada. Pengkajian tidak dilakukan sepenuhnya. Diagnosa belum sesuai nomenklatur, perencanaan belum ditulis di buku CM. Pelaksanaan asuhan belum dilakukan secara komperhensif.

Disarankan kepada Dinas Kesehatan untuk: mengadakan penyegaran ilmu dan ketrampilan bidan mengenai asuhan pelayanan nifas sesuai standar. Selain itu juga memfasilitasi form pencatatan asuhan pelayanan nifas sesuai standar, dan melakukan monitoring dan menyediakan SOP tentang pelayanan nifas.

**ABSTRACT**

**Analysis of Input and Process of Postnatal Care Services by Midwife at Semarang City Health Office in 2014**

Coverage of postnatal services in Semarang City from 2011 to 2013 increased but it had not achieved the target (90%). A preliminary study revealed that postnatal care provided by midwives at Semarang City Health Office (CHO) was not maximal. This research aimed to explain input and process of postnatal care at Semarang CHO.

This was qualitative research. Data were collected by conducting indepth interview and observing. Main informants consisted of 2 midwives selected from 2 health centers with highest and lowest coverage of postnatal visit. Meanwhile, 2 coordinator midwives and 2 heads of health centers selected from these health centers were as informants for triangulation purpose. Furthermore, data were analyzed using content analysis.

The results of this research showed that the implementation of care viewed from the input aspect as follows: there was a shortfall in the number of midwives, knowledge of midwives about postnatal care was still low, and a policy for implementing postnatal care services in accordance with a standard was not available. In addition, analysis had been done comprehensively, diagnose was not in accordance with nomenclature, plan had not been recorded on a Medical Record book, and postnatal care services had not been implemented comprehensively.

As a suggestion, Health Office needs to refresh knowledge and skills of midwives about postnatal care services in accordance with a standard. In addition, the office needs to facilitate a recording form of the services in accordance with a standard, monitor, and provide SOP of the services.
